 provisions of the State Constitution.
 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE
- 4 OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 5 Section 1. That at the next general election held in the state, the following amendment to
- 6 Article VI, section 2 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, as set forth in section 2
- 7 of this Joint Resolution, which is hereby agreed to, shall be submitted to the electors of the state
- 8 for approval.
- 9 Section 2. That Article VI, section 2 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, be
- amended to read as follows:
- § 2. No person shall be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of law. The
- 12 right of persons to work shall not be denied or abridged on account of membership or
- 13 nonmembership in any labor union, or labor organization.
