1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions concerning the licensure of
2 polygraph examiners.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 36-30-3 be amended to read as follows:

5 36-30-3. A person may receive a license as a polygraph examiner if, which is valid for three
6 years if the person:

7 (1) ~~He establishes~~ Establishes that he or she is a person of good moral character;

8 (2) ~~He has~~ Has satisfactorily completed at least six weeks of study in the use of a
9 polygraph in detection of deception or establishes that he or she is an experienced
10 and competent polygraph examiner based upon work experience; and

11 (3) ~~He submits~~ Submits an application to the ~~attorney general's office~~ Office of the
12 Attorney General along with a nonrefundable ~~twenty-five~~ seventy-five dollar license
13 fee.
