A person may receive a license as a polygraph examiner if, which is valid for three 6 years if the person: 7 (1) He establishes Establishes that he or she is a person of good moral character; He has Has satisfactorily completed at least six weeks of study in the use of a 8 (2) 9 polygraph in detection of deception or establishes that he or she is an experienced 10 and competent polygraph examiner based upon work experience; and 11 (3) He submits Submits an application to the attorney general's office Office of the 12 Attorney General along with a nonrefundable twenty-five seventy-five dollar license 13 fee.
