- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit local exchange carriers from assessing certain
- 2 access stimulation charges and to establish certain penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. No local exchange carrier may assess an access stimulation charge. For the
- 5 purposes of this section, the term, access stimulation charge, means any switched access charge
- 6 assessed by a local exchange carrier upon a connecting carrier for delivery of
- 7 telecommunications during which a free or below cost service or product is provided by an
- 8 entity with which the local exchange carrier has a business, financial, or contractual arrangement
- 9 relating directly or indirectly to any switched access revenue from the offering of such service
- 10 or product.
- 11 Section 2. Any person who violates section 1 of this Act is subject to a civil penalty to be
- imposed by the Public Utilities Commission, after notice and opportunity for hearing. The
- commission may impose a civil fine of not more than twenty thousand dollars for each offense.
- 14 In determining the amount of the penalty upon finding a violation, or the amount of the
- 15 compromise settlement, the commission shall consider the appropriateness of the penalty to the

- 1 size of the business of the person charged, prior offenses and compliance history, the good faith
- 2 of the person charged in attempting to achieve compliance, and such other matters as justice
- 3 may require. All penalties collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited in the state
- 4 treasury. In addition to assessing a civil penalty for a violation of section 1 of this Act, the
- 5 commission may revoke or suspend a telecommunications company's certificate of authority for
- 6 repeated offenses.
