- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the requirement to report the names of students
- who are deaf, blind, or visually impaired.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-27-10 be repealed.
- 5 13-27-10. The president of the school board shall send to the superintendent of the School
- 6 for the Deaf the names of all deaf children of proper age residing in the school district, and to
- 7 send to the superintendent of the School for the Blind and the Visually Impaired the names of
- 8 all blind or visually impaired children of proper school age residing in the school district,
- 9 whenever the residence of such children in need within the board's jurisdiction becomes known
- 10 to the board. The superintendents of the respective schools shall take all necessary action to
- 11 provide that such children in need shall be given the advantages of proper education.
