1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the requirement to report the names of students
2 who are deaf, blind, or visually impaired.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 13-27-10 be repealed.

5 ~~—13-27-10. The president of the school board shall send to the superintendent of the School~~
6 ~~for the Deaf the names of all deaf children of proper age residing in the school district, and to~~
7 ~~send to the superintendent of the School for the Blind and the Visually Impaired the names of~~
8 ~~all blind or visually impaired children of proper school age residing in the school district,~~
9 ~~whenever the residence of such children in need within the board's jurisdiction becomes known~~
10 ~~to the board. The superintendents of the respective schools shall take all necessary action to~~
11 ~~provide that such children in need shall be given the advantages of proper education.~~
