- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain fees charged by sheriffs.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 7-12-18 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 7-12-18. The sheriff shall charge and remit the following:
- 5 (1) For serving an order of arrest with commitment or bail bond and return, ten twenty-
- 6 five dollars;
- 7 (2) For each search on a search warrant, four dollars:
- 8 (3) For arresting under search warrant, each defendant, six dollars;
- For serving summons, complaint, warrant of attachment, affidavit, notice and undertaking in claim and delivery, or injunction, order to show cause, citation, or other process, and return thereof, sixteen dollars and fifty cents of the instrument, fifty dollars for all such process or instruments served at the same time upon the same person regardless of the capacities in which such person is served, but. However, for all such process or instruments served upon another such person at approximately the
- same time at the same place, five ten dollars;



1 (5)(3) For serving subpoena for witness, each person, seven dollars and fifty cents twenty-2 five dollars; 3 For taking and filing undertaking in claim and delivery or other indemnification to 4 be furnished to and approved by the sheriff, six dollars; 5 (7)(4) For traveling expenses in cars or planes owned by the sheriff, or necessary emergency 6 vehicles a motor vehicle, a minimum mileage allowance of at least three cents over 7 and above the rate set for state employees by the State Board of Finance but not more than six cents above the rate set for state employees by the State Board of Finance, 8 9 as shall be determined by the board of county commissioners, for each mile actually 10 and necessarily traveled by car; ten cents above. The board of county commissioners 11 shall provide for a minimum mileage charge, not to exceed ten dollars, for any travel 12 less than ten miles. If the distance traveled is ten miles or more, the sheriff shall 13 receive the minimum mileage charge plus an additional amount for each mile or part 14 of a mile traveled over ten miles based on a mileage allowance that does not exceed the rate set for state employees by the State Board of Finance by more then ten cents 15 16 per mile. For traveling expenses in a private plane, a minimum mileage allowance 17 that does not exceed the rate set for state employees by the State Board of Finance 18 for each mile actually and necessarily traveled by private plane; except by more than 19 ten cents per mile. However, actual cost may be paid for travel by train, bus, plane, 20 or other commercial vehicle; 21 (8)(5) For serving writ of execution and return thereof of the instrument, whether satisfied 22 or unsatisfied, sixteen fifty dollars; 23 (9)(6) For levying writ of possession, eleven twenty-five dollars. However, if the sale of the property levied upon is not subsequently held, the actual costs or expenses associated 24

24		received and disbursed by the sheriff on execution or order of sale, order of

attachment, decree or on sale of real property or personal property, for each dollar not exceeding four hundred dollars, nine cents; for each dollar above four hundred dollars, and not exceeding one thousand dollars, five cents; for each dollar above one thousand dollars, not to exceed fifteen thousand dollars, three two hundred thousand dollars, five cents; but. However, in no case may the commission be less than fifteen twenty-five dollars. The commissions shall be included as a part of the cost of execution, order of sale, order of attachment, decree, or on sale of real or personal property, which shall be paid by the debtor out of the proceeds. However, in all cases of redemption prior to the sale, the sheriff is entitled to the commission as stated above, to be paid by the redemptioner as a cost of the redemption; For cases in the circuit court, if persons, in whose favor an execution or order $\frac{(22)}{(12)}$ of sale is issued, bid in the property sold on execution or decree, the sheriff or officer making the sale shall receive the following compensation: If the amount for which the property is bid in is one thousand dollars or less, the sum of twenty dollars; if. If the amount for which the property is bid in is more than one thousand dollars, the sum of forty one hundred dollars; (23)(13)For making a sale of real property under a foreclosure of mortgage by advertisement, the same fees as for the sale of real property under a judgment of foreclosure and sale of real property; and $\frac{(24)}{(14)}$ If personal property is taken by the sheriff on execution or warrant of attachment and applied in the satisfaction of the debt without sale, the same percentage on the appraised value of the property as in the case of a sale and all additional reasonable and necessary costs and expenses incurred in
