## HOUSE BILL NO. 1113

Introduced by: Representatives Weems, Elliott, Heineman, Miles, Rounds, Thompson, Van Etten, and Willadsen and Senators Olson (Ed), Dempster, Gant, Garnos, Katus, Peterson (Jim), and Two Bulls

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to add two nonvoting student members to the South Dakota
- 2 Board of Education.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 1-45-6.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 1-45-6.1. There is created within the Department of Education the South Dakota Board of
- 6 Education. The South Dakota Board of Education shall consist of nine <u>voting</u> members <u>and two</u>
- 7 nonvoting student members, one high school junior and one high school senior. The All
- 8 members shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The
- 9 Governor shall initially appoint, from a list of names submitted by the South Dakota Board of
- Education pursuant to section 2 of this Act, one nonvoting student member who is a junior in
- high school for a term of two years and one nonvoting student member who is a senior in high
- school for a term of one year. Thereafter, the Governor shall annually appoint, from a list of
- 13 <u>names submitted by the South Dakota Board of Education, a nonvoting student member who</u>
- is a junior in high school for a term of two years. If a vacancy occurs among the nonvoting
- student members, the Governor shall appoint a new member to serve out the unexpired term

- 1 from among a list of names submitted by the board that, if possible, contains the names of
- 2 students who had previously applied for membership on the board and were recommended by
- 3 <u>the board, but not appointed to serve.</u> The terms of office for each <u>voting</u> member shall be four
- 4 years and shall terminate December thirty-first of the fourth year.
- 5 Section 2. That chapter 1-45 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 6 follows:
- Any student, with the consent of the student's parent or guardian if the student is a minor,
- 8 in grade ten may apply to the South Dakota Board of Education to serve as a nonvoting student
- 9 member during the student's junior and senior years in high school. The board shall promulgate
- rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 establishing the application procedures and timelines, and the
- criteria that the board will use to select the applicants whose names will be forwarded to the
- Governor for consideration. In selecting applicants to recommend to the Governor, the board
- shall consider an applicant's academic record and participation in extracurricular activities and
- 14 community activities.
