1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for promotional displays by vehicle dealers
2 under certain conditions.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-6B-19 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-6B-19. Any person licensed under this chapter, who sells vehicles at locations other than
6 the principal place of business, shall obtain a supplemental license for each auxiliary or
7 supplemental lot not contiguous to the location for which the original license is issued. If the
8 license is granted, the licensee may be permitted to use unimproved lots and premises for sale,
9 storage, and display of vehicles. Supplemental lots and premises shall be located within the
10 county of the principal place of business of the applicant and shall meet local zoning codes or
11 ordinances. No supplemental license is required for display of vehicles within the corporate
12 limits of a municipality where the vehicle dealer is licensed or if one or more licensed vehicle
13 dealers wish to display their vehicles on a temporary supplemental lot as defined in § 32-6B-1.
