- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit certain money lenders from providing a

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 54-4 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 No licensee may enter into a short-term consumer loan contract with any person with whom
- 7 the licensee has had a previous short-term consumer loan contract unless three business days
- 8 have elapsed since the previous short-term consumer loan contract has been paid in full.
