1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to restrict the entry of conservation officers onto certain 2 private land without permission. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That chapter 41-2 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 5 follows: 6 No conservation officer may, in the course of performing the ordinary duties of a 7 conservation officer, enter any private land unless the conservation officer has the permission 8 of the landowner or the lessee. However, any conservation officer may enter any private land 9 without permission: 10 (1) If reasonable suspicion or probable cause exists that a violation of a law that the 11 conservation officer is authorized to enforce has been, is being, or is about to be 12 committed; 13 (2) To investigate a report of illegal hunting, fishing, or trapping activity; 14 (3) To dispatch crippled or distressed wildlife;

To respond to emergency situations, accidents, or other threats to public safety.
