1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the South Dakota State Library to continue to 2 circulate popular books to citizens. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 14-1-44 be amended to read as follows: 5 14-1-44. The State Library Office shall be responsible for executing the library policy of the State of South Dakota and shall: 6 7 (1) Promote adequate library service for all the people of the state; 8 (2) Supplement the services of libraries throughout the state; (3) Increase the proficiency of library personnel through provision of in-service and 10 continuing education programs for library personnel employed in the state; 11 (4) Provide for the citizens of the state specialized library services and materials not 12 generally appropriate, economical, or available in other libraries of the state; 13 **(5)** Maintain a collection of popular books at its central location in Pierre which shall be 14 circulated to citizens; 15 (5)(6) Coordinate the libraries maintained by the executive department of state government - 2 - HB 1215

- 1 within the governmental complex in Pierre;
- 2 (6)(7) Establish and operate a state publications library distribution center; and
- (7)(8) Collect and publish annual statistical data of libraries in the state.
