1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for a study of medicaid.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. The Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council shall establish an
4 interim committee to study ways in which to achieve greater efficiency in health care delivery
5 for the medicaid recipients in the state. The committee shall specifically study ways to improve
6 care, reduce costs, and empower the recipients of medicaid with choices in services. The
7 committee shall invite the testimony of health care providers, recipients of medicaid, and any
8 other interested parties. A report of the committee shall be presented to the 2008 Legislative
9 Session.
