1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain provisions regarding the treatment of
2 Indian tribes for purposes of unemployment insurance.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 61-6A-1 be repealed.

5 ~~61-6A-1. For the purposes of §§ 61-6A-1 to 61-6A-14, inclusive, the term, employer,~~
6 ~~includes any Indian tribe for which service in employment as defined under Title 61 is~~
7 ~~performed. The term, tribal unit, means subdivisions, subsidiaries, or business enterprises,~~
8 ~~wholly owned by an Indian tribe.~~

9 Section 2. That §§ 61-6A-2 to 61-6A-14, inclusive, be repealed.

10 Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person who was receiving
11 unemployment benefits prior to the enactment of chapter 61-6A shall be deemed eligible to
12 receive those same unemployment benefits on and after July 1, 2007.
