## HOUSE BILL NO. 1260

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain provisions regarding the treatment of
- 2 Indian tribes for purposes of unemployment insurance.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 61-6A-1 be repealed.
- 5 61-6A-1. For the purposes of §§ 61-6A-1 to 61-6A-14, inclusive, the term, employer,
- 6 includes any Indian tribe for which service in employment as defined under Title 61 is
- 7 performed. The term, tribal unit, means subdivisions, subsidiaries, or business enterprises,
- 8 wholly owned by an Indian tribe.
- 9 Section 2. That §§ 61-6A-2 to 61-6A-14, inclusive, be repealed.
- Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person who was receiving
- unemployment benefits prior to the enactment of chapter 61-6A shall be deemed eligible to
- receive those same unemployment benefits on and after July 1, 2007.
