- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the restriction on certain political campaign
- 2 contributions by Indian tribes.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 12-27-21 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 12-27-21. No candidate, political committee, or political party may accept any contribution
- from any state, state agency, political subdivision of the state, foreign government, Indian tribe,
- 7 federal agency, or the federal government. A violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
