1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain signs to identify polling places on election
2 day.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 12-14 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 On election day a sign, with a minimum size of eleven inches by seventeen inches, shall be
7 conspicuously displayed outside of the entrance to any building in which a polling place is
8 located to clearly identify the building as a polling place.
