1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to limit state expenditures.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. The State of South Dakota's total annual expenditures may not increase more than  
4 the lesser of three percent or the index factor, as defined in section 2 of this Act, over the  
5 amount of state expenditures in the preceding year. Total annual expenditures include state,  
6 federal, and other funds. The Governor's proposed budget shall also meet the requirements of  
7 this Act.

8 Section 2. The index factor is the annual percentage change in the consumer price index for  
9 urban wage earners and clerical workers as computed by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, United  
10 States Department of Labor, for the preceding year.
