- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide that incontestability provisions in certain life
- 2 insurance policies do not apply in cases of fraud.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 58-16-35 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 58-16-35. A policy of group life insurance shall contain a provision that the validity of the
- 6 policy shall may not be contested, except for nonpayment of premiums, after it has been in force
- 7 for two years from its date of issue; and that no statement made by any person insured under the
- 8 policy relating to his the person's insurability shall may be used in contesting the validity of the
- 9 insurance with respect to which such statement was made, after such insurance has been in force
- prior to the contest for a period of two years during such person's lifetime-nor. No statement
- made by the group policyholder or any person insured under the group policy may be contested
- unless it is contained in a written instrument signed by him that person. The two-year limitation
- 13 for contesting the validity of the insurance for any person insured under the policy does not
- apply to fraud on the part of the applicant or insured.
- 15 Section 2. That § 58-15-10 be amended to read as follows:

- 2 - HB 1206

58-15-10. There shall be a provision that the policy, exclusive of provisions relating to

- 2 health benefits or to additional benefits in the event of death by accident or accidental means,
- 3 shall be is incontestable, except for nonpayment of premiums or fraud on the part of the
- 4 <u>applicant or insured</u>, after it has been in force during the lifetime of the insured for a period of
- 5 two years from its date of issue.
