1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to increase funding for certain providers of medical services
2 and to make an appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the health care trust fund the sum of four
5 million nine hundred thirty-nine thousand ninety-six dollars (\$4,939,096), or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, to the Department of Social Services for the purpose of providing an
7 increase of one and two-tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

8 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of eight million four hundred seven
9 thousand eighty-nine dollars (\$8,407,089), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in federal
10 fund expenditure authority to the Department of Social Services for the purpose of providing
11 an increase of one and two-tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

12 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of two thousand seven hundred seventy-two
13 dollars (\$2,772), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in other fund expenditure authority
14 to the Department of Social Services for the purpose of providing an increase of one and two-



1 tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

2 Section 4. The secretary of the Department of Social Services shall approve vouchers and
3 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by sections 1 to 3, inclusive,
4 of this Act.

5 Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from the health care trust fund the sum of seven
6 hundred twenty-nine thousand six hundred seventy-six dollars (\$729,676), or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, to the Department of Human Services for the purpose of providing an
8 increase of one and two-tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

9 Section 6. There is hereby appropriated the sum of nine hundred twenty-three thousand
10 forty-two dollars (\$923,042), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in federal fund
11 expenditure authority to the Department of Human Services for the purpose of providing an
12 increase of one and two-tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

13 Section 7. There is hereby appropriated the sum of three thousand six hundred forty-two
14 dollars (\$3,642), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in other fund expenditure authority
15 to the Department of Human Services for the purpose of providing an increase of one and two-
16 tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

17 Section 8. The secretary of the Department of Human Services shall approve vouchers and
18 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by sections 5 to 7, inclusive,
19 of this Act.

20 Section 9. There is hereby appropriated from the health care trust fund the sum of one
21 hundred forty-three thousand six hundred twenty-three dollars (\$143,623), or so much thereof
22 as may be necessary, to the Department of Corrections for the purpose of providing an increase
23 of one and two-tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

24 Section 10. There is hereby appropriated the sum of ninety-seven thousand six hundred

1 forty-eight dollars (\$97,648), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in federal fund
2 expenditure authority to the Department of Corrections for the purpose of providing an increase
3 of one and two-tenths percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

4 Section 11. The secretary of the Department of Corrections shall approve vouchers and the
5 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by sections 9 to 10, inclusive,
6 of this Act.

7 Section 12. There is hereby appropriated from the health care trust fund the sum of sixteen
8 thousand nine hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$16,929), or so much thereof as may be necessary,
9 to the Unified Judicial System for the purpose of providing an increase of one and two-tenths
10 percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

11 Section 13. The state court administrator of the Unified Judicial System shall approve
12 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by section 12
13 of this Act.

14 Section 14. There is hereby appropriated the sum of thirty-nine thousand fifteen dollars
15 (\$39,015), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in federal fund expenditure authority to the
16 Department of Education for the purpose of providing an increase of one and two-tenths percent
17 for providers of medicaid-funded services.

18 Section 15. The secretary of the Department of Education shall approve vouchers and the
19 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by section 14 of this Act.

20 Section 16. There is hereby appropriated the sum of ten thousand nine hundred seventy-nine
21 dollars (\$10,979), or so much thereof as may be necessary, in other fund expenditure authority
22 to the Department of Health for the purpose of providing an increase of one and two-tenths
23 percent for providers of medicaid-funded services.

24 Section 17. The secretary of the Department of Health shall approve vouchers and the state

1 auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by section 16 of this Act.

2 Section 18. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
3 June 30, 2011, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

4 Section 19. The entire amount appropriated in sections 1, 5, 9, and 12 of this Act, shall be
5 repaid with interest from the general fund to the health care trust fund. On June thirtieth of each
6 fiscal year, if the percentage growth in general fund revenues for the fiscal year exceeds the sum
7 of the prior year's general fund revenues adjusted by the annual percentage change in the
8 consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical workers as computed by the Bureau
9 of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor for the year before the year
10 immediately preceding the year of repayment, the amount in excess shall be transferred from
11 the general fund to the health care trust fund, until such time as the total amount with interest
12 has been repaid. The interest rate used to calculate the repayment amount shall equal the average
13 interest rate earned by the state cash flow fund over the last four quarters as supplied by the
14 South Dakota Investment Council.
