

I. the state of being enslaved to a habit or practice or to something that is psychologically or physically habit-forming, as narcotics, to such an extent that its cessation causes severe trauma.





 - Intensive Outpatient
 - CBISA
 - MRT
 - DBT
 - Specialized Relapse Prevention

TRADITIONAL PROCESSING


- Treatment NEEDS Assessment
- Treatment plan developed
- Levels of Care/includes all BUT:
 - Does not include Preparatory Group
 - Does not include Specialized Relapse
 Prevention
 - Does include Slip-Slot




Total Number of Participants









STATEWIDE DEMOGRAPHICS DUI COURT **FY12-FY19**
