[SB 64*](#) provide certain provisions regarding the regulation of recreational park trailers.
[SB 65](#) define intentional exposure to HIV infection by sexual intercourse as a sex crime subject to registry as a sex offender.
[SB 69](#) add marijuana to the list of abusive substances for the purposes of determining child abuse.
[SB 84](#) revise certain miscellaneous provisions of the trust statutes.
