- SB 183 (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) permit the creation of a transportation district and to establish its powers and bonding authority.
- SB 190\* (Deferred from 15<sup>th</sup> LD) impose a fee on certain pipelines carrying crude oil and to create a crude oil pipeline compensation fund that may be used in the event of a crude oil spill.
- <u>SB 40</u>\* establish certain requirements regarding the separation and protection of a gas and electric public utility's assets.
- <u>SB 109</u> authorize the Fourth Circuit drug court program in the Unified Judicial System and to make an appropriation therefor.
- <u>SB 143\*</u> revise certain provisions regarding collection and administration of the 911 emergency surcharge and operation of 911 services.
- <u>SB 161</u>\* create the South Dakota Boxing Commission and to provide for the supervision of boxing and kickboxing competitions and sparring exhibitions in the state.
