CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

Amended SJ 24th LD: HB 1047, 1051, 1255 DO NOT PASS: HB 1261

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

* Amended

- <u>HB 1096</u>* authorize the court appointment of parenting coordinators in certain custody and visitation disputes.
- <u>HB 1099</u>* require custody or visitation dispute mediation under certain circumstances.
- <u>HB 1143</u> repeal certain requirements related to school district employee retirement benefits.
- <u>HB 1164</u> authorize the purchase or lease of computer hardware and software through the general fund of school districts.
- <u>HB 1212</u> allow the marketing of group insurance for wireless telecommunications equipment under certain conditions.
- <u>HB 1213</u>* provide a uniform standard for processing of accident and health carrier policy rate and form filings.
- <u>HB 1293</u>* provide for the removal of dead deer from certain highways.

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- <u>HB 1090</u>* (Removed from Consent Calendar) require that most records and applications regarding a child reference the names and addresses of both parents.
- HJR 1001 To propose a constitutional amendment to repeal certain provisions of the State Constitution relating to corporations.
- <u>HB 1139</u>* revise certain provisions of the South Dakota Business Corporations Act regarding the issuance of shares and cumulative voting for directors.
- <u>HB 1148</u> exempt the land application of certain solid waste used for irrigation purposes from requirements related to large-scale solid waste facilities.
- <u>HB 1210</u>* prohibit recyclers, scrap metal dealers, or scrap yard operators from purchasing certain beer kegs.
- <u>HB 1245</u>* clarify certain purposes and characteristics of water development districts, to revise the boundaries of the Central Plains, East Dakota, Vermillion Basin, James River, and South Central water development districts, and to revise provisions related to the board of directors in the affected districts.
- <u>HB 1288</u> allow any school district that qualifies for both the declining enrollment allowance and the growing enrollment payment in the same fiscal year to only benefit from the one that provides the most additional funding to the district.
