- HB 1241* (Deferred from 33rd LD) provide for the delivery of special education or special education and related services to a child during the child's transition from one state school district to another.

- <u>HB 1007</u>* increase certain noncommercial and commercial motor vehicle license fees and to increase the fuel excise tax on certain fuel used by motor vehicles.
- <u>HB 1070</u>* revise certain fees pertaining to seed permits and nursery certificates of inspection.
- <u>HB 1072</u>* repeal certain provisions concerning the delayed remittance of sales and use taxes for certain businesses.
 - <u>Increase the gross receipts tax imposed on visitor-related businesses.</u>
- <u>HB 1252</u> repeal certain provisions relating to the education enhancement tobacco tax fund.
- <u>HB 1260</u>* require that a request for proposals be issued for certain state contracts for professional services.
- <u>HB 1264*</u> provide for the utilization of conditional early release bonds in regard to certain furloughs and paroles.
- <u>HB 1278*</u> revise certain provisions prohibiting political subdivisions from restricting firearms.
- <u>HB 1281</u>* enhance funding for state highways, to increase fees on certain signs, displays, or devices, and to provide certain penalties.
 - Enhance funding for state highways by increasing fees on certain signs, displays, or devices.
