#### SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

(Deferred from 21<sup>st</sup> LD)stabilize the funding of the state aid to education formula for two years by appropriating money from the education enhancement trust fund and borrowing money from certain school districts, to create the education stabilization fund, and to prohibit school districts from imposing an excess tax levy for two years.

- SB 184 (Deferred from 21st LD)make appropriations from the water and environment fund, the water pollution control revolving fund subfund, and the drinking water revolving fund subfund for various water and environmental purposes, to revise the state water plan, and to declare an emergency. (Deferred from 21st LD)revise certain provisions related to distribution of funds to **SB** 186 sparse school districts. (Deferred from 21<sup>st</sup> LD)revise certain budgetary provisions relating to certain funds SB 189 received from the federal government. (Deferred from 21st LD)revise certain allocations for disabilities in the state aid for SB 192 special education formula. (Removed from table) classify certain farm winery land as agricultural. <u>SB 74</u> **SB** 77\* require school boards to approve pick-up locations for any open enrolled students who are transported in their resident school districts by receiving school districts.
- SB 145 revise the provisions concerning the types of taxes that the state may enter into compacts with Indian tribes.
- <u>SB 168</u>\* revise certain provisions regarding certain state purchases of supplies and services.

- HB 1034\* (Deferred from 21st LD)repeal the requirement for motor vehicle liability insurance safety rating discounts for certain older motor vehicle drivers.

- <u>HB 1045</u>\* authorize dental hygienists to provide preventive and therapeutic services to more persons under certain circumstances.
