- <u>HB 1041</u> (Deferred from 27th LD)revise the statutory duties of the presiding judge of each judicial circuit.
- (Deferred from 28th LD)authorize the South Dakota Building Authority to issue revenue bonds to provide for maintenance and repair on facilities controlled by the Board of Regents and to provide appropriations therefor.
- <u>HB 1047</u> (Deferred from 28th LD)revise certain prairie dog shooting season provisions.
- <u>HB 1070</u>* (Deferred from 28th LD) prohibit school districts from employing school counselors who are not certified.
- <u>HB 1085</u>* (Deferred from 28th LD)prohibit certain political advertising in highway rights-of-way.
- HB 1119* (Deferred from 28th LD) revise the procedure for reissuing certain alcoholic beverage licenses.
- <u>HB 1146</u>* (Deferred from 28th LD)limit copayment or coinsurance amounts for chiropractic services.
- HB 1173* (Deferred from 28th LD)administer, conduct, and provide for fair elections.

 Require the person in charge of local elections to notify the secretary of state when the dates of elections have been set.
- <u>HB 1207</u>* (Deferred from 28th LD)allow the consignment or auction of certain out-of-state vehicles and motorcycles.
- <u>HB 1216</u>* (Deferred from 28th LD)prohibit certain contract restrictions on the use of ethanol blender pumps by retailers.
- (Deferred from 28th LD)make an appropriation to reimburse certain family physicians, midlevel practitioners, and dentists who have complied with the requirements of the physician tuition reimbursement program, the midlevel tuition reimbursement program, and the dental tuition reimbursement program.
- <u>HB 1247</u> (Deferred from 28th LD)make an appropriation to fund property and sales tax refunds for certain elderly persons and persons with a disability.
- <u>HB 1249</u> (Deferred from 28th LD)authorize a carryover of the fiscal year 2011 state aid to special education appropriation to fiscal year 2012.
- HB 1056* (Removed from Consent Calendar)establish an additional time period during which fireworks may be sold and discharged and to revise certain provisions regarding county regulation of fireworks.
- (Placed by Motion) establish a co-curricular fund and a co-curricular property tax levy for school districts to meet expenditures for co-curricular activities.

 Establish the jump start scholarship program.
- HB 1008* authorize the Board of Regents to expend higher education facilities funds to maintain and repair certain facilities occupied under capital leases.
- <u>HB 1192</u>* increase certain registration fees for the use of motor vehicles on the public highways.
- <u>HB 1196</u>* provide for the establishment of veterans resource centers at certain state colleges and universities.
- <u>HB 1248</u>* repeal the sunset of the one-half percent increase in the gross receipts tax imposed on visitor-related businesses.
