HB 1097 revise certain provisions regulating the investment of unneeded state operating expenses in banks.  
HB 1125 clarify the definition of engaging in business in certain circumstances.  
HB 1229 exempt certain persons from the requirement to license as a mortgage loan originator.  
HB 1095 revise the procedure for the discharge of civil judgments against a person who has received a discharge of debt pursuant to the United States Code, Title 11.  
HB 1114 amend provision limiting the time used to determine if a violation is a third or subsequent offense.  
HB 1160 provide for the award of filing fees as court costs in certain appeals.  
HB 1194 revise certain provisions regarding the payment for rape and sexual offense examinations.  
HB 1245\* revise certain provisions regarding the suspension of a driver license for certain alcoholic beverage violations.

## SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1018 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) repeal certain obsolete or unnecessary provisions pertaining to the Department of Game, Fish and Parks.
- HB 1066\* (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) allow for the cremation of deceased persons who are indigent and the funeral expenses are the financial responsibility of the county.
- HB 1131\* (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) ) revise certain provisions relating to the posting of public notice for meetings of public bodies.
- HB 1046\* (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) revise certain provisions regarding child custody during a soldier's deployment.
- HB 1064 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) allow the Supreme Court to establish certain rules for the use of interactive audio visual equipment and to provide for the collection and deposit of fees for the use thereof.
- HB 1059\* (Removed from Consent Calendar) revise Article 9 of the Uniform Commercial Code.
- HB 1121 (Removed from Consent Calendar) amend rate stability provisions to include plant additions.
- HB 1083\* provide for term limits for brand board service.
- HB 1227\* revise certain provisions with regard to the rights of industrial and construction equipment dealers.
- HB 1039 exempt certain impaired driving violations from the statutory limitation on enhanced penalties for second, third, or subsequent violations.
- HB 1117 provide for the taking of muskrats by shooting under certain conditions.
- HJR 1006 Proposing and submitting to the electors at the next general election an amendment to Article XIII, sections 20 and 21 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to the trust fund created from the proceeds of the state cement enterprise sales.
- HB 1017 authorize the Bureau of Administration to construct a maintenance shop in Pierre, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- HB 1051\* authorize the South Dakota Building Authority and the Board of Regents to implement the long-term capital project request of the Board of Regents providing for the demolition, construction, remodeling, or renovation of various structures on the campuses of the state's universities and to make appropriations therefor.
- HB 1164\* ~~appropriate money for the repair of state-owned dams managed by the Office of School and Public Lands and the Department of Game, Fish, and Parks.~~  
Revise certain provisions regarding the sale of certain surplus property in Yankton County.
- HB 1199\* revise certain provisions related to the distribution of funds to sparse school districts.
