- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow students who have dyslexia to receive special
- 2 education or special education and related services.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That ARSD 24:05:24.01:01 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 24:05:24.01:01. Students with disabilities are students evaluated in accordance with chapter
- 6 24:05:25 as having autism, deaf-blindness, deafness, hearing loss, cognitive disability, multiple
- disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairments, emotional disturbance, specific
- 8 learning disabilities, dyslexia, speech or language impairments, traumatic brain injury, or vision
- 9 loss, including blindness, which adversely affects educational performance, and who, because
- of those disabilities, need special education or special education and related services. If it is
- determined through an appropriate evaluation, under chapter 24:05:25, that a student has one
- of the disabilities identified in this chapter, but only needs a related service and not special
- education, the student is not a student with a disability under this article. If, consistent with this
