- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to change the South Dakota virtual high school to the South
- 2 Dakota virtual school.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-33-24 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-33-24. There is created the South Dakota virtual high school. The South Dakota virtual
- 6 high school shall be under the control of the Department of Education. The South Dakota virtual
- 7 high school shall provide choice accessibility, flexibility, quality, and equity in curricular
- 8 offerings for high school-aged students in the state.
- 9 Section 2. That § 13-33-25 be amended to read as follows:
- 10 13-33-25. The South Dakota Virtual High School Advisory Council is established. The
- 11 council shall advise the Department of Education, the South Dakota Board of Education,
- education-related organizations, and other education groups on issues related to distance
- learning. The council shall meet quarterly with the Department of Education to discuss, develop,
- and make recommendations for the promulgation of rules concerning policies that affect
- 15 distance delivery.

- 1 Section 3. That § 13-33-28 be amended to read as follows:
- 2 13-33-28. The Department of Education may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 to
- 3 coordinate course offerings by the South Dakota virtual high school, to award course credits
- 4 earned by students taking classes from the South Dakota virtual high school, and to establish
- 5 criteria for school districts to participate in the South Dakota virtual high school.
- 6 Section 4. That § 13-33-29 be amended to read as follows:
- 7 13-33-29. No school district may grant credit for any course successfully completed through
- 8 distance learning as defined in § 13-33-20 unless the course is offered through the South Dakota
- 9 Virtual High School.
- However, a school district may grant credit for a distance learning course offered through
- an entity other than the South Dakota Virtual High School if any of the following conditions
- 12 apply:
- 13 (1) The course is provided through an agreement among accredited school districts;
- 14 (2) The course is a university course taken by a student who is dually enrolled pursuant
- to the provisions of § 13-28-37;
- 16 (3) The course was previously taken through an accredited high school or other
- accredited provider by a student who subsequently transferred into the school district;

- 19 (4) The course is not available through the South Dakota Virtual High School and is pre-
- approved by the secretary of education.
