House Bill 1010

Introduced by: The Committee on Commerce and Energy at the request of the State Plumbing Commission

1 **An Act to revise the renewal date and maximum renewal fee of certain licenses**
 2 **issued by the plumbing commission.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

5 **36-25-33. Expiration and renewal of licenses.**

6 Beginning July 1, 2021, any new license issued under § 36-25-19 expires every
 7 three years on December thirty-first and may only be renewed on or before the
 8 immediately following January thirty-first.

9 Any person licensed with the commission prior to July 1, 2021, shall be transitioned
 10 to a three-year renewal cycle and pay renewal fees on December 31, 2021, as follows:

11 (1) Licensees with last names beginning with A through J shall pay one-third of the
 12 license fee set forth in rule and be subject to renewal on December 31, 2022;

13 (2) Licensees with last names beginning with K through Q shall pay two-thirds of the
 14 licensee fee as set forth in rule and be subject to renewal on December 31, 2023;
 15 and

16 (3) Licensees with last names beginning with R through Z shall pay the full fee set
 17 forth in rule and be subject to renewal on December 31, 2024.

18 **Section 2.** That § 36-25-19 be AMENDED.

19 **36-25-19. Application for license--Examination--Fees.**

20 A person may apply for a license required by this chapter to the commission,
 21 accompanied by a license fee established by the commission under this section. If the
 22 person is not entitled to a renewal, the commission shall register a person who
 23 satisfactorily passes an examination showing fitness to practice the person's trade.
 24 Examinations may be held in conjunction with any quarterly meeting of the commission.

1 ~~A license issued under this section expires on December thirty first and may be~~
2 ~~renewed no later than the immediately following January thirty first.~~

3 The commission shall promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to establish
4 examination and reexamination fees, and license and renewal of license fees for: plumbing
5 contractor, plumber, water conditioning contractor, water conditioning installer, appliance
6 contractor, appliance installer, sewer and water contractor, sewer and water installer,
7 manufactured and mobile home contractor, manufactured and mobile home installer,
8 underground irrigation contractor, and underground irrigation installer. No fee established
9 under this section for an examination or reexamination may exceed one hundred dollars.
10 No fee established under this section for a license or renewal of license may exceed ~~three~~
11 nine hundred dollars.
