~~Commencing January 1, 2010, each~~ Each applicant for renewal of a plumbing contractor, plumber, restricted plumbing contractor, restricted plumber, or third year apprentice plumber licensed as an apprentice plumber by examination shall successfully complete a minimum of ~~four~~ eight hours of continuing education relating to the plumbing trade during the ~~previous calendar year~~ two-year license cycle. An applicant for new licensure as a plumbing contractor or plumber by reciprocity shall successfully complete ~~four~~ eight hours of continuing education relating to the plumbing trade prior to license issuance.
