AMENDMENT 74C FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

## 1 An Act to revise certain provisions regarding drones.

## 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 22-21-1 be AMENDED.

4	2	2-21-1. EavesdroppingPrivacyMisdemeanor.
5		No person may, except as authorized by law:
6	(1)	Trespass on property with intent to subject anyone to eavesdropping or other
7		surveillance in a private place; <u>or</u>
8	(2)	Install in any private place, without the consent of the person or persons entitled
9		to privacy there, any device for observing, photographing, recording, amplifying, or
10		broadcasting sounds or events in such place, or uses any such unauthorized
11		installation <del>;</del>
12	<del>(3)</del>	Intentionally use a drone to photograph, record, or otherwise observe another
13		person in a private place where the person has a reasonable expectation of privacy;
14		<del>Or</del>
15	<del>(4)</del>	Land a drone on the lands or waters of another resident provided the resident owns
16		the land beneath the water body in its entirety without the owner's consent, except
17		in the case of forced landing and the owner or lessee of the drone will be liable for
18		any damage resulting from a forced landing.
19		A person who violates this section is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. Subdivisions
20	<del>(2)</del> a	and (3) do Subdivision (2) does not apply to law enforcement officers, or to those
21	actin	g under the direction of a law enforcement officer, while engaged in the performance
22	of th	e officer's lawful duties. Subdivisions (3) and (4) do not apply to a drone operator
23	opera	ating a drone for bona fide business or bona fide government purposes who
24	unint	entionally or incidentally photographs, records, or otherwise observes another person

2	50-15-5. EavesdroppingViolation of privacyMisdemeanor.	
3	No person may, except as authorized by law, intentionally use a drone to	
4	photograph, record, or otherwise observe another person in a private place where the	
5	person has a reasonable expectation of privacy. A person who violates this section is guilty	
6	of a Class 1 misdemeanor.	
7	This section does not apply to:	
8	(1) Law enforcement officers, or to those acting under the direction of a law	
9	enforcement officer, while engaged in the performance of the officer's lawful	
10	duties;	
11	(2) A drone operator operating a drone for bona fide business or bona fide government	
12	purposes who unintentionally or incidentally photographs, records, or otherwise	
13	observes another person in a private place; or	
14	(3) A designated emergency management worker operating a drone within the scope	
15	of the worker's duties.	
16	Section 3. That a NEW SECTION be added:	
17	50-15-6. TrespassingDroneMisdemeanor.	
18	No person may, except as authorized by law, land a drone on the lands or waters	
19	of another resident if that resident owns the land beneath the water body in its entirety	
20	without the owner's consent. In-It is an affirmative defense if the landing was a forced	
21	landing, but in the case of forced landing, the owner or lessee of the drone is-remains	
22	liable for any damage resulting from a forced landing. A person who violates this section	
23	is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
