House Bill 1018

HOUSE MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS ENGROSSED

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of the Military

- An Act to authorize the construction of a National Guard Readiness Center in Sioux Falls, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.**The Department of the Military may contract for the planning, site preparation,
- 5 <u>construction, furnishing, and equipping of the construction of a National Guard Readiness</u>
- 6 <u>Center, together with furnishings and equipment, including heating, air conditioning,</u>
- 7 plumbing, water, sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks, parking, landscaping, architectural and
- 8 engineering services, and such other services or actions as may be required to accomplish
- 9 the project, for an estimated cost of twenty million dollars, subject to permitted adjustments
- 10 pursuant to section 3 of this Act.
- 11 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$5,000,000, and
- 12 the sum of \$15,000,000 in federal fund expenditure authority to the Department of the
- 13 <u>Military, for purposes of design and construction of a National Guard Readiness Center in</u>
- 14 Sioux Falls.
- 15 **Section 3.** The Department of the Military may adjust the cost estimates to reflect inflation
- as measured by the Building Cost Index reported by the Engineering News Record, additional
- expenditures required to comply with regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act,
- or additional sums received pursuant to section 4 of this Act. However, any adjustments to
- 19 construction cost estimates for the project may not exceed one hundred twenty-five percent
- of the estimated project construction cost stated in section 1 of this Act.
- 21 **Section 4.** In addition to the amounts appropriated in section 2 of this Act, the Department
- 22 of the Military may accept and expend for the purpose of this Act any funds obtained from
- 23 gifts, contributions, or any other source if the acceptance and expenditure is approved in
- 24 accordance with § 4-8B-10.

- **Section 5.** The design and construction of this project shall be under the general charge and
- 2 <u>supervision of the Department of the Military. The adjutant general of the Department of the</u>
- 3 <u>Military or the state engineer shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants</u>
- 4 to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 5 **Section 6.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 6 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 7 **Section 7.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 8 <u>existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in</u>
- 9 <u>full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
