

2021 South Dakota Legislature House Bill 1229

1An Act to establish fees for information provided from the statewide voter2registration file.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

5	12	-4-37.1 Statewide voter registration fileFees for electronic copies.
6		The fees for obtaining a copy of an electronic file with voter registration information
7	<u>are as</u>	follows:
8	<u>(1)</u>	Statewide complete file, five hundred dollars;
9	<u>(2)</u>	Statewide complete file for new parties or parties with alternative political status
10		for just their party voters:
11		(a) Ten dollars for one thousand names or less;
12		(b) Twenty-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;
13		(c) Fifty dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names, inclusive;
14		and
15		(d) One hundred dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;
16	<u>(3)</u>	Legislative district complete file, twenty-five dollars;
17	<u>(4)</u>	County or any other district complete file:
18		(a) Five dollars for one thousand names or less;
19		(b) Fifteen dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;
20		(c) Twenty-five dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
21		inclusive; and
22		(d) Fifty dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;
23	<u>(5)</u>	Any updated partial file that contains only changes made within a year after the
24		purchase of a complete file:
25		(a) Fifty dollars for a statewide partial file; and
26		(b) Ten dollars for a legislative district, any other district, or county partial file.

3		The fees for obtaining a paper list with voter registration information are as follows:			
4	<u>(1)</u>	Statewide complete list, one thousand five hundred dollars;			
5	<u>(2)</u>	Statewide complete list for new parties or parties with alternative political status			
6		for just their party voters:			
7		(a) Ten dollars for one thousand names or less;			
8		(b) Thirty dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;			
9		(c) One hundred dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,			
10		inclusive; and			
11		(d) Two hundred fifty dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;			
12	<u>(3)</u>	Legislative district complete list, seventy-five dollars;			
13	<u>(4)</u>	County or any other district complete list:			
14		(a) Fifteen dollars for one thousand names or less;			
15		(b) Forty-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;			
16		(c) Seventy-five dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,			
17		inclusive; and			
18		(d) One hundred fifty dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;			
19	<u>(5)</u>	Any updated partial list that contains only changes made within a year after the			
20		purchase of a complete list:			
21		(a) One hundred fifty dollars for a statewide partial list; and			
22		(b) Thirty dollars for a legislative district, any other district, or county partial			
23		<u>list.</u>

27		The fees for obtaining a copy of an electronic file with daily absentee voter			
28	regis	tration information per election are as follows:			
29	<u>(1)</u>	Statewide complete file, seven hundred fifty dollars;			
30	<u>(2)</u>	Legislative district complete file, forty dollars; and			
31	<u>(3)</u>	County complete file:			
32		(a) Fifteen dollars for one thousand names or less;			
33		(b) Twenty-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;			

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1		(c) Forty dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
2		inclusive; and
3		(d) Seventy-five dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names.
4	Section	4. That § 12-4-39 be AMENDED.
5	1	2-4-39. Promulgation of rulesScope.
6		The secretary of state may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 concerning:
7	(1)	Procedures for the establishing the statewide voter registration file;
8	(2)	Transmission of the voter registration information from the county to the Office of
9		the Secretary of State;
10	(3)	Procedures for determining duplicate voter registration; and
11	(4)	Dissemination of the information from the statewide voter registration file; and
12	(5)	Establishment of fees for information provided from the statewide voter registration
13		file .
