



## 2021 South Dakota Legislature

# House Bill 1264

*Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Office of the Governor*

1 **An Act to make appropriations from the water and environment fund and its**  
 2 **revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes and**  
 3 **to declare an emergency.**

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund  
 6 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of \$10,000,000 to the Board of Water and  
 7 Natural Resources, for purposes of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under the  
 8 consolidated water facilities construction program established pursuant to § 46A-1-63.1.  
 9 Funds shall be provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water  
 10 and Natural Resources.

11 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the South Dakota water and environment fund  
 12 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60, the sum of \$2,500,000 to the Board of Water and Natural  
 13 Resources for purposes of providing grants and loans to project sponsors under the solid  
 14 waste management program established pursuant to § 46A-1-83. Funds shall be provided  
 15 according to the terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural  
 16 Resources.

17 The Department of Environment and Natural Resources may use up to \$250,000 of the  
 18 funds appropriated by this section, to contract for the statewide cleanup of waste tires and  
 19 solid waste. Notwithstanding § 46A-1-61, the department may fund up to one hundred  
 20 percent of the nonfederal share of statewide waste tires and solid waste cleanup projects.

21 **Section 3.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees  
 22 deposited in the South Dakota state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund  
 23 established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of \$1,250,000 to the Board of Water and  
 24 Natural Resources for purposes of providing water quality grants under the state water  
 25 pollution control revolving fund program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds shall

1 be provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural  
2 Resources.

3 **Section 4.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees  
4 deposited in the state water pollution control revolving fund program subfund established  
5 pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of \$200,000 to the Board of Water and Natural Resources  
6 for purposes of contracting for the preparation of applications and administration of clean  
7 water state revolving fund loans under the state water pollution control revolving fund  
8 program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds shall be provided according to terms  
9 and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

10 **Section 5.** There is hereby appropriated from administrative expense surcharge fees  
11 deposited in the state drinking water revolving fund program subfund established pursuant  
12 to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of \$50,000 to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for  
13 purposes of providing small system technical assistance grants and contracting for the  
14 preparation of applications and administration of drinking water state revolving fund loans  
15 under the state drinking water revolving fund program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1.  
16 Funds shall be provided according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water  
17 and Natural Resources.

18 **Section 6.** There is hereby appropriated from federal funds deposited in the state drinking  
19 water revolving fund program subfund established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1, the sum of  
20 \$75,000 to the Board of Water and Natural Resources for purposes of providing small system  
21 technical assistance set-aside grants to project sponsors under the state drinking water  
22 revolving fund program established pursuant to § 46A-1-60.1. Funds shall be provided  
23 according to terms and conditions established by the Board of Water and Natural Resources.

24 **Section 7.** The secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall  
25 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized  
26 by this Act.

27 **Section 8.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall  
28 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

29 **Section 9.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its  
30 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in  
31 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
