On the Introduced bill, delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

- Section 1. <u>There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$1 to the</u> <u>Department of Agriculture, for the purpose of memorializing former</u> <u>representative Bob Glanzer at the livestock and equestrian complex at the</u> <u>State Fair.</u>
- Section 2. <u>The secretary of the Department of Agriculture shall approve vouchers and the</u> <u>state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
- Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

Section 4. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
