AMENDMENT 103B FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

An Act to provide for the confidentiality of personal information of persons affiliated with nonprofit corporations and to provide a penalty therefor.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

5 47-24-18. Personal affiliation information--Definitions. Terms used in §§ 47-24-18 to 47-24-22 47-24-23, inclusive, mean: 6 "Personal affiliation information," any list, record, register, registry, roll, roster, or 7 (1) other compilation of data of any kind that directly or indirectly identifies a natural 8 9 person as a member, supporter, volunteer, or donor of financial or nonfinancial 10 support to any nonprofit corporation; and 11 (2) "Public agency," any state or local governmental unit in this state, including any 12 department, agency, office, commission, board, division, county, municipality, township, school district, court, or other judicial or guasi-judicial body. 13 14 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added: 15 47-24-19. Personal affiliation information--Right to privacy--Public 16 agencies--Prohibitions. 17 Any natural person who supports a nonprofit corporation has a right to personal privacy and confidentiality regarding the release of personal affiliation information by a 18 19 public agency. A public agency may not:

20 (1) Require any natural person or nonprofit corporation to provide the public agency
21 with personal affiliation information or otherwise compel the release of personal
22 affiliation information;

4	<u>(3)</u>	Release, publicize, or otherwise publicly disclose personal affiliation information in

6	(4) (3)	Request or require a current or prospective contractor or grantee with the public
7		agency to provide the public agency with a list of nonprofit corporations to which
8		it has provided financial or nonfinancial support.
9		A person who knowingly violates this section is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.

12		Personal affiliation information is precluded from public disclosure in accordance

20		The provisions of §§ 47-24-18 to 47-24-22 47-24-20, inclusive, do not apply to:
21	<u>(1)</u>	Any report or disclosure required by the secretary of state for campaign finance
22		purposes pursuant to chapter 12-27;
23	<u>(2)</u>	Any filing required of a nonprofit corporation pursuant to chapters 47-22 to 47-28,
24		<u>inclusive;</u>
25	<u>(3)</u>	Any lawful warrant for personal affiliation information issued by a court of
26		competent jurisdiction;
27	<u>(4)</u>	A lawful request for discovery of personal affiliation information in litigation if the
28		following conditions are met:
29		(a) The requestor demonstrates a compelling need for the personal affiliation
30		information by clear and convincing evidence; and
31		(b) The requestor obtains a protective order barring disclosure of personal
32		affiliation information to any person not named in the litigation;

1	<u>(5)</u>	Admission of personal affiliation information as relevant evidence before a court of
2		competent jurisdiction. However, no court filing may publicly reveal personal
3		affiliation information absent a specific finding of good cause;-or
4	<u>(6)</u>	A review of personal affiliation information necessary for a sales or use tax audit
5		of a nonprofit corporation by the Department of Revenue,; or
6	<u>(7)</u>	A review of personal affiliation information necessary for purposes of an audit,
7		examination, or investigation of a nonprofit corporation pursuant to chapter 4-11.
8	Section	5. That a NEW SECTION be added:

10		A person alleging a violation of § 47-24-19 may bring a civil action for appropriate
11	injunctive relief, actual damages, or both.

13	costs of litigation, including reasonable attorney fees and witness fees, to the complainant	
14	<u>in the</u>	action if the court determines that the award is appropriate.

17		Personal affiliation information derived from a donation to a nonprofit corporation
18	<u>that i</u>	s affiliated with a public agency may be disclosed if the donor has not previously
19	<u>reque</u>	sted anonymity from the nonprofit corporation.

21	47	7-24-23. Personal affiliation informationFraud investigation.
22		The provisions of § 47-24-19 do not apply to any information required for, or
23	<u>obtair</u>	ned in the course of, a state fraud investigation or an enforcement action by the
24	<u>state.</u>	Any information obtained shall be confidential, and its disclosure is restricted as
25	provid	led by law.
