AMENDMENT 163A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1	An Act to revise the eligibility requirements for compassionate parole under certain	
2	circumstances.	
3	BE IT E	NACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
4	Section	1. That § 24-15A-55 be AMENDED.
5	24-15A-55. Eligibility for compassionate parole.	
6		Notwithstanding any contrary provision in chapter 24-13, 24-15, or 24-15A, an
7	inmate who:	
8	(1)	Has a terminal illness;
9	(2)	Is seriously ill and not likely to recover;
10	(3)	Requires extensive medical care or significant chronic medical care;
11	(4)	Is at least sixty-five years of age, has served at least ten consecutive years of the
12		inmate's sentence incarcerated, whose current sentences are for convictions of a
13		Class 3 felony or below-lower and whose medical care needs are at least double the
14		average annual medical cost of the inmate population; or
15	(5)	Is at least seventy years of age and has served at least thirty consecutive years of
16		the inmate's sentence incarcerated; and
17	(6)	Is not serving a capital punishment sentence;
18		is eligible for compassionate parole consideration.
19		During a global pandemic as declared by the World Health Organization, eligibility
20	for c	ompassionate parole consideration is extended to all inmates who are at an increased
21	<u>risk</u>	of illness due to an existing underlying medical condition as defined by the Centers
22	for Disease Control and Prevention and whose current sentences are for convictions of a	

Class 3 felony or lower for crimes that are not violent as provided in § 24-15A-32.
