AMENDMENT 1254F FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

- 1 An Act to prohibit preferential treatment in higher education employment practices.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That § 13-49-14 be AMENDED.

13-49-14. Employment of officers, instructors and employees--

Compensation and terms of employment--Political opinions not considered.

The Board of Regents may employ and dismiss all officers, instructors, and employees of such institutions, necessary to the proper management thereof, to determine their number, qualifications, and duties, fix the term of their employment, and rate and manner of their compensation, provide for sabbatical leave on part pay, and provide for a retirement program. However, no

<u>No</u> person may be employed or dismissed, or accorded preferential, adverse, or unequal treatment with respect to any application, hiring, training, apprenticeship, tenure, promotion, upgrading, compensation, layoff, or any term or condition of employment, by reason of any the person's ideological,:

- (1) <u>Ideological</u>, political, or sectarian or political opinions held, <u>or perspectives</u>, or activities; or
- (2) Race, color, creed, religion, sex, ancestry, disability, or national origin.

No person may, as a condition of initial or continued employment, be explicitly or implicitly required to support, adopt, or advance a particular ideological, political, or sectarian point of view.
