## House Bill 1115

AMENDMENT 1115A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

## 1 An Act to revise the qualifications of Game, Fish and Parks commissioners.

- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 41-2-2 be AMENDED.

6	Not more than four of the game, fish and parks commissioners may be members
7	<del>of the same political party, and, at <u>At</u> the time of their</del> appointment <u>, a commissioner must</u>
8	be a resident of the state., at least
9	Not more than four game, fish and parks commissioners shall be farmers
10	agricultural producers actually residing on a farm or working primarily on a farm, engaged
11	in agriculture, deriving at least two-thirds of their gross annual incomes from crop or
12	livestock production or both, and interested in wildlife conservation. At the time of their
13	appointment, no more than two of the agricultural producers shall reside west of the
14	Missouri River and no more than two shall reside east of the Missouri River.
15	At the time of their appointment, three commissioners shall reside west of the
16	Missouri River and five shall reside east of the Missouri River.
17	At least four commissioners, who are not agricultural producers, must actively
18	hunt, fish and or camp, and shall have purchased a license and or permit to do so in the
19	state of South Dakota three of the preceding four years.
20	Section 2. That § 41-2-3 be AMENDED.
21	41-2-3. Terms of office of commissionersAnnual appointments

- 22 **Restrictions on appointments.**
- 23 The term of office of the game, fish and parks commissioners is four years. The
- 24 Governor shall preserve:

- (1) An an arrangement of length of terms whereby two members have terms expiring
  each year;
- 3 (2) A rotation of terms between the republican and democratic parties.

The expiration of terms occurs on the tenth day of January of each year, and all required appointments shall-<u>must</u> be made by the first day of March. The appointments <del>shall-<u>must</u> fill all vacancies on the commission arising either by expiration of term or from</del> any other cause.

8 No person may serve on the commission for more than eight years. However, if <u>If</u> the 9 person's first appointment is for two years, the person may be reappointed thereafter for 10 no more than two additional four-year terms.
