AMENDMENT 191A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the redesign and renovation
of an addition to the South Dakota State University Meat Lab provide an
appropriation for a study regarding the future renovation and expansion of
the Meat Laboratory on the campus of South Dakota State University, to make
an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 7 Section 1. The Board of Regents may contract for the redesign and renovation of, and the
- 8 design and construction of, a twenty-two-thousand-square-foot addition to the South Dakota
- 9 State University Meat Lab within the Animal Science Complex on the campus of South Dakota
- 10 State University in Brookings, together with furnishings and equipment, including heating, air
- 11 <u>conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks, parking, landscaping,</u>
- 12 architectural and engineering services, and other services or actions as may be required to
- 13 accomplish the project, for an estimated cost not to exceed \$25,000,000, subject to permitted
- 14 adjustments pursuant to section 3 of this Act.
- 15 Section 21. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$25,000,000
- 16 <u>\$600,000 to the Board of Regents, for the purposes authorized in section 1 of this Act purpose</u>
- 17 of conducting a comprehensive planning study regarding the future renovation and expansion
- 18 of the meat laboratory, within the Animal Science Complex, on the campus of South Dakota
- 19 State University. The study must include project details, space confirmation, equipment
- 20 <u>needs, options for construction of new space, and options for repurposing the existing space.</u>
- 21 **Section 3.** The cost estimates contained in this Act have been stated in terms of 2020 values.
- 22 The Board of Regents may adjust such cost estimates to reflect inflation as measured by the
- 23 Building Cost Index, reported by the Engineering News Record, and additional expenditures
- 24 required to comply with regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act. However, any

- 1 adjustments to construction cost estimates for the project may not exceed one hundred
- 2 <u>twenty-five percent of the estimated project construction cost stated in section 1 of this Act.</u>
- 3 Section 4. The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any funds obtained for
- 4 the project authorized in this Act from federal sources, donations, or any other external
- 5 <u>sources, all of which comprise a special fund for the benefitted project.</u>
- 6 Section 5. The administration of the design and construction of the project authorized in this
- 7 Act shall be under the general charge and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as
- 8 provided in chapter 5-14.
- 9 Section 62. <u>The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the</u>
- 10 <u>state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
- 11 Section 73. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 12 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 13 Section 84. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 14 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 15 <u>full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
