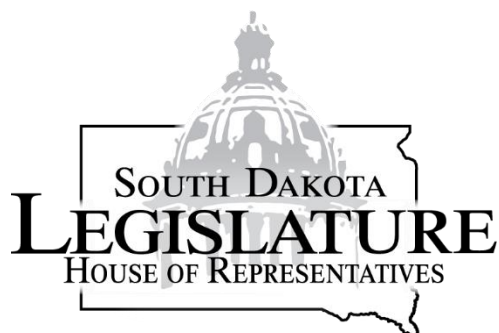

MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1069 (Deferred from 24th LD; Consideration of Senate Amendments) modify the expenditures that are recoverable as disbursements by a prevailing party in a civil action or a special proceeding. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1079 (Deferred from 24th LD; Consideration of Senate Amendments) limit certain actions that may be taken by the executive branch relative to nonprofit corporations or charitable trusts. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1090 (Consideration of Senate Amendments) modify certain requirements for domestic not-for-profit corporations and to declare an emergency. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HCR 6008 To reauthorize the Mental Health Services Delivery Task Force for the limited purposes of monitoring the growth and development of current initiatives in the delivery of mental health services, reviewing and proposing adjustments to the levels of funding, and ensuring that the statutory and regulatory framework complements intended outcomes. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1254 prohibit preferential treatment in higher education employment practices. (House Education Engrossed)
- HB 1258 revise certain provisions regarding cosmetology apprentice programs. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1261 revise certain provisions related to the training curricula required of a person appointed as a guardian or a conservator. (House Education Engrossed)
- HB 1110 prohibit the performance of abortions due to Down syndrome and to provide a penalty therefor. (House State Affairs Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1263 provide price transparency for health care costs. (Introduced)

- HB 1130 establish requirements for the presentation of a written statement regarding
the discontinuance of a drug-induced abortion.
(House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1203 authorize banks to engage in business with industrial hemp or marijuana
licensees and associated persons. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1241 provide for participation in a parent education program upon filing for divorce.
(House Education Engrossed)
- HB 1124 modify certain requirements concerning the printing of ballots.
(House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1100 modify the medical marijuana program and to create an interim committee to
recommend implementation of the medical marijuana program.
(House State Affairs Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 96 revise certain provisions regarding the use of telehealth technologies.
(Introduced)
- SB 59 revise the allocation of fees collected by the obligation recovery center and to
revise certain venue, jurisdiction, and collection efforts regarding the co-
owners of titled motor vehicles, motorcycles, and boats. (Introduced)
