JOINT APPROPRIATIONS ENGROSSED

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Office of the Governor

An Act to authorize the Department of Agriculture to contract for the construction of a livestock and equestrian complex at the State Fair, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** The Department of Agriculture is hereby authorized to contract for the planning,
- 6 <u>site preparation, construction, furnishing, and equipping of a livestock and equestrian complex</u>
- 7 at the State Fair, including any heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer, electric
- 8 facilities, sidewalks, parking, landscaping, architectural and engineering services, and any
- 9 other services or actions required to accomplish the project, for an estimated cost of
- 10 \$20,000,000, subject to any adjustments authorized in section 3 of this Act.
- 11 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$12,000,000 to
- 12 <u>the Department of Agriculture. There is also appropriated the sum of \$8,000,000 in other</u>
- 13 <u>fund expenditure authority to the Department of Agriculture, consisting of the Beef Complex</u>
- insurance proceeds and the amount received by the Department of Agriculture under section
- 15 4 of this Act.
- 16 **Section 3.** The cost estimates contained in this Act are stated in terms of 2020 values. The
- 17 Department of Agriculture may adjust the cost estimates to reflect inflation as measured by
- 18 the Building Cost Index, reported by the Engineering News Record, and to reflect additional
- 19 expenditures required to comply with regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act,
- and to reflect additional costs incurred pursuant to section 5 of this Act. Any adjustments to
- 21 construction cost estimates for the project may not exceed one hundred twenty-five percent
- of the estimated project construction cost stated in section 1 of this Act.
- 23 **Section 4.** The Department of Agriculture may accept, transfer, and expend any funds
- obtained for the projects authorized in this Act from federal sources, donations, or any other
- 25 external sources, all of which comprise a special fund for the benefitted project. All moneys

- 1 deposited into that fund are hereby appropriated to the projects authorized by this Act,
- 2 <u>subject to limitations stated in sections 1 to 3, inclusive, of this Act.</u>
- 3 **Section 5.** The Department of Agriculture may demolish, remove, and dispose of the
- 4 structures known as Open Class Sheep Barn, consisting of approximately thirty-seven
- 5 thousand square feet, at the State Fair. This project includes demolition, abatement of
- 6 asbestos or any other hazardous materials, lawful disposal of the fixtures or rubble, and any
- 7 other action reasonably necessary to prepare the lot for the construction of the livestock and
- 8 <u>equestrian complex authorized in section 1 of this Act.</u>
- 9 **Section 6.** The administration of the design and construction of the project authorized in this
- 10 Act shall be under the general charge and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as
- 11 provided in chapter 5-14.
- 12 **Section 7.** The secretary of the Department of Agriculture shall approve vouchers and the
- 13 <u>state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
- 14 **Section 8.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 16 **Section 9.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 17 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 18 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
