AMENDMENT 1191A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1	An Act to allow an expedited process for local intergovernmental legal disputes.
2	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
3	Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added:
4	15-6-72.1. Local intergovernmental actionsExpedited actionAlternative
5	dispute resolution.
6	In order to facilitate the quick and efficient resolution of disputes, whenever two or
7	more local governmental bodies are engaged in a legal dispute, on motion of any party
8	or on its own, the court may order the parties to proceed:
9	(1) Under the expedited civil action process set out in §§ 15-6-73 to 15-6-76.1,
10	inclusive, regardless of any amount in controversy; or
11	(2) To alternative dispute resolution, other than binding arbitration, on such terms as
12	the court may order.
13	Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added:
14	15-6-72.2. DefinitionLocal government body.
15	For the purposes of § 15-6-72.1, the term, local government body, shall mean:
16	(1) Any county, municipality, township, or unincorporated territory;
17	(2) Any school district;
18	(3) Any organization that offers a public service, organized or authorized by a county,
19	municipality, or township, including law enforcement, fire protection services, or

(3)(4) Any special district including ambulance districts under chapter 34-11A,

conservation districts under chapter 38-8, consumer power districts under chapters

49-35 through 49-40, drainage basis utility districts under chapter 46A-10B, improvement districts under chapter 7-25A, irrigation districts under chapters 46A-
