- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:
- 6

34-54-1. Heroes wellness grant.

7 <u>The Department of Public Safety shall establish and administer the heroes wellness</u>
 8 <u>grant. Funds shall be expended as appropriated by the Legislature.</u>

- 9 **Section 2.** That a NEW SECTION be added:
- 10 **34-54-2.** Grant--Oversight--Purposes.

11 All moneys for the heroes wellness grant shall be used and expended under the 12 direction of the secretary of public safety. The secretary shall provide grants to eligible applicants for the purpose of creating, establishing, and developing first responder peer 13 support programs and first responder critical incident stress management programs within 14 15 the state. Grants shall be provided for training programs that are, or are similar to those, 16 developed by the International Critical Incident Stress Foundation, Inc. First responders, 17 whether volunteer or professional, include any member of a: 18 (1)Law enforcement organization; 19 (2) Fire suppression organization; 20 (3) Emergency medical service, including emergency medical technicians and 21 paramedics; and

- 22 (4) An organization providing emergency dispatch services to any organization listed
 23 in this section.
- 24 **Section 3.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

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An applicant shall submit an application to the secretary on a form prescribed by the secretary. The secretary shall, by rules promulgated pursuant to chapter 1-26, develop administrative procedures regarding the application and grant award process including any scoring system to be used to evaluate or rank applications. The secretary shall act as fiscal agent for the grant and shall be responsible for receiving and reviewing grant applications and awarding grants under this chapter. The secretary shall give consideration to regions within the state that may have more significant need.

9 <u>At least thirty days before the first day applications may be submitted each fiscal</u> 10 <u>year, the secretary shall publish on the office's website the specific criteria and any scoring</u> 11 <u>system used to evaluate or rank applications and award grants under this chapter. The</u> 12 <u>commissioner shall also post any unserved or underserved areas that are eligible for grant</u> 13 <u>funding.</u>

14 **Section 4.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

- 15 **34-54-4.** Application--Contents.
- 16 <u>An applicant for a grant under this section shall provide the following information</u>
- 17 <u>on the application:</u>
- 18 (1) The location of the project;
- 19 (2) The proposed training;
- 20 (3) The number of personnel to be trained;
- 21 (4) The total cost of the training and associated expenses; and
- 22 (5) Any additional information requested by the secretary.
- 23 **Section 5.** That a NEW SECTION be added:
- 24 34-54-5. Grant funds--Use. 25 Grant funds may be used for: 26 (1)Costs and expenses associated with hosting and coordinating an eligible training; 27 (2) Per diem for food and lodging, at the rate established under \S 3-9-2, for each full 28 day a person provides or participates in a training funded under this grant; and Mileage, at the rate established under § 3-9-1, to and from the training for each 29 (3) 30 person that provides or participates in a training funded under this grant. **Section 6.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$200,000, to the 31
- 32 Department of Public Safety, for the purposes of creating an endowment to provide ongoing

- 2 <u>endowment, held in trust and vested with the South Dakota Community Foundation, and</u>
- 3 administered by the Department of Public Safety.
- 4 **Section 7.** The funds appropriated in section 6 of this Act shall be transferred to the South
- 5 Dakota Community Foundation to fund the South Dakota Heroes Wellness endowment, to be
- 6 <u>administered in accordance with the provisions of this Act.</u>
- 7 Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$50,000 to the
- 8 Department of Public Safety, for the heroes wellness grant.
- 9 Section 9. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 10 revert, in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 11 Section 10. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety shall approve vouchers and the
- 12 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 13 Section 11. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 14 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 15 <u>full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
