## Senate Bill 103

#### AMENDMENT 103D FOR THE SENATE COMMERCE AND ENERGY BILL

# An Act to provide for the confidentiality of personal information of persons affiliated with nonprofit corporations.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

## 47-24-18. Personal affiliation information--Definitions. Terms used in §§ 47-24-18 to 47-24-23, inclusive, mean:

- 7 (1) "Personal affiliation information," any list, record, register, registry, roll, roster, or
  8 other compilation of data of any kind that directly or indirectly identifies a natural
  9 person as a member, supporter, volunteer, or donor of financial or nonfinancial
  10 support to any nonprofit corporation; and
- (2) "Public agency," any state or local governmental unit in this state, including any
  department, agency, office, commission, board, division, county, municipality,
  township, school district, court, or other judicial or guasi-judicial body.
- 14 **Section 2.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

#### 15 47-24-19. Personal affiliation information--Right to privacy--Public 16 agencies--Prohibitions. Any natural person who supports a nonprofit corporation has a right to personal 17 privacy and confidentiality regarding the release of personal affiliation information by a 18 19 public agency. A public agency may not: 20 Require any natural person or nonprofit corporation to provide the public agency (1) 21 with personal affiliation information or otherwise compel the release of personal 22 affiliation information; 23 Release, publicize, or otherwise publicly disclose personal affiliation information in (2) 24 the public agency's possession; or

| 30 | <u>(6)</u>    | A review of personal affiliation information necessary for a sales or use tax audit     |

| 32 | <u>(7)</u>    | A review of personal affiliation information necessary for purposes of an audit,        |
| 33 |               | examination, or investigation of a nonprofit corporation pursuant to chapter 4-11.      |

- 1 Section 5. That a NEW SECTION be added: 47-24-22. Personal affiliation information--Public benefit. 2 3 Personal affiliation information derived from a donation to a nonprofit corporation 4 that is affiliated with a public agency may be disclosed if the donor has not previously 5 requested anonymity from the nonprofit corporation. 6 **Section 6.** That a NEW SECTION be added: 7 47-24-23. Personal affiliation information--Fraud investigation. 8 The provisions of § 47-24-19 do not apply to any information required for, or
- 9 <u>obtained in the course of, a state fraud investigation or an enforcement action by the</u>
- 10 <u>state. Any information obtained shall be confidential, and its disclosure is restricted as</u>
- 11 provided by law.
