## JOINT APPROPRIATIONS ENGROSSED

Introduced by: Senator Hunhoff

- 1 An Act to establish criteria for a regional nursing facility designation, to provide an 2 appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 3
- 4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

5	3	4-12-35.12. Regional nursing facilityDesignation.
6		A nursing facility may submit to the Department of Human Services an application
7	for de	esignation as a regional nursing facility. In order to obtain the designation, a nursing
8	facilit	ty must:
9	(1)	Be enrolled and in good standing with South Dakota Medicaid;
LO	(2)	Provide home and community-based services in the region through an affiliation or
L1		a contractual arrangement;
2	<u>(3)</u>	Demonstrate intent to construct a new nursing facility or to substantially remodel
.3		an existing facility, upon merging with one or more health care facilities within a
4		thirty-mile radius;
.5	(4)	Demonstrate that the newly constructed nursing facility or the substantially
.6		remodeled facility will:
.7		(a) Support a homelike environment with a cluster, neighborhood, or household
.8		model layout;
.9		(b) Contain single occupancy rooms and toilet areas;
.0		(c) Abide by best practices regarding infection control and prevention;
1		(d) Allow for private visitation; and
2		(e) Support other best practices related to aging;
.3	<u>(5)</u>	Meet any other criteria set forth in rules promulgated by the department for the

25		Upon approval of the application and completion of the construction or remodeling
26	refer	enced in this section, the department shall designate the facility as a regional nursing

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1 facility. Upon a determination by the department that the proposal is budget-neutral for 2 South Dakota Medicaid, the department shall reimburse the facility in accordance with the 3 regional nursing facility rate methodology. 4 The department shall promulgate rules, in accordance with chapter 1-26, to 5 implement this section. 6 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of 7 \$6,000,000 to the Governor's Office of Economic Development, for the purposes of 8 awarding grants to: 9 (1) Entities renovating vacated nursing facilities in accordance with § 34-12-35.12; 10 (2) Reimburse nursing facilities for reasonable costs incurred in preparing a regional 11 plan; 12 Assist entities with the costs of engaging in other acts consistent with a regional or (3) 13 community health plan approved by the office; or 14 Assist entities with the costs of any other activity approved by the state. (4) 15 The Governor's Office of Economic Development may accept grant applications 16 from a regional nursing facility for a period of one year after the facility is awarded that designation in accordance with § 34-12-35.12. 17 No grant awarded under this section for the renovation of a vacated nursing facility 18 may exceed the lesser of one million dollars or fifty percent of the total renovation cost. 19 20 Section 3. The commissioner of the Governor's Office of Economic Development shall 21 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized 22 by this Act. 23 **Section 4.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act now lawfully expended or obligated shall 24 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8. 25 **Section 5.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its 26 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in

full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

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
