- 3 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

In	order to facilitate the quick and efficient resolution of disputes, whenever two or
<u>more l</u>	ocal governmental bodies are engaged in a legal dispute, on motion of any party
<u>or on i</u>	ts own, the court may order the parties to proceed:
<u>(1)</u>	Under the expedited civil action process set out in §§ 15-6-73 to 15-6-76.1,
	inclusive, regardless of any amount in controversy; or
<u>(2)</u>	To alternative dispute resolution, other than binding arbitration, on such terms as
	the court may order.
