

Below is a list of written public requests regarding ARPA funding at the November 18, 2021 COVID Relief Liaison Committee meeting. This document is intended to consider the eligibility of these projects under the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds only. These projects may be eligible under different programs funded through ARPA.

Current eligibility is based on the Interim Final Rule. Potential eligibility is based on the current language of S. 3001, which is subject to change.

Comments on eligibility are ***not*** intended to be legal advice on the actual eligibility of any projects, but rather initial opinions based on available information from the federal government.

Transitioning buses to electric	Ineligible	Eligible as infrastructure
Drinking water/wastewater infrastructure	Eligible under section II.D.1	Eligible
Expanding public transit	Ineligible	Eligible as infrastructure
Premium pay for essential workers	Eligible under II.B (\$25,000 per eligible worker)	Eligible
Providing airline services	Ineligible	Eligible as government services under II.C
Affordable housing/rentals	Eligible only when provided to disproportionately impacted communities under section II.A.2	Eligible as government services under II.C
State park management	Ineligible	Eligible as government services under II.C
General educational infrastructure	Ineligible	Eligible as government services under II.C
Money for low-income families	Eligible under section II.A.2	Eligible
Rent/mortgage assistance	Eligible under section II.A.2	Eligible
Medicaid expansion	Ineligible (must use state funding)	Ineligible

Affordable day care/childcare services	Eligible only when provided to disproportionately impacted communities under section II.A.2	Eligible as government services under II.C
Preschool for all children	Ineligible	Eligible as government services under II.C
Long hauler financial assistance	Eligible under section II.A.2	Eligible
Creating a civics curriculum	Ineligible	Eligible as government services under II.C
Rural hospital funding	Eligible under section II.A.1 if the purpose is to prevent the spread of COVID-19	Eligible
Incentives for vaccination	Eligible under section II.A.1	Eligible
Grant to Feeding South Dakota	Eligible under section II.A.2	Eligible
Mental health resources	Eligible under section II.A.1	Eligible
Family skills training programs	Eligible only when provided to disproportionately impacted communities under section II.A.2	Eligible as government services under II.C
Homeless shelters	Eligible only when provided to disproportionately impacted communities under section II.A.2	Eligible as government services under II.C
Domestic abuse shelters	Eligible only when provided to disproportionately impacted communities under section II.A.2	Eligible as government services under II.C
